Carriageway Resurfacing Works - A875 Killearn, near Co-op, Main Street

Due to the continuing deteriorating condition of the A875 Main Street, Killearn outside the Coop as per attached plan, we have rescheduled the carriageway resurfacing works. These works will now commence Tuesday 14th August for approximately 1 week, weather and resource dependant.

During these works, for the safety of the general public and workmen, a full **Road Closure** must be put in place for the full extent of the works. The Road Closure will be from:

- Tuesday 14th August to Friday 17th August 8am to 6pm.
- Potentially Sunday 19th August 8am to 6pm.
- Monday 20th August onwards 9am to 3pm (to allow school traffic through access).

No on-street parking will be available at this location during the works. Access for emergency services will be available at all times.

Beech Drive

Access will be maintained for residents of Beech Drive, give and take will be required at some stages where plant etc. is working at the junction to allow time to move and make safe for passing through. Please allow extra time for journeys to avoid any delays. The access will be for one direction only; if working at the Co-op side a right turn only system will be put in place and if working at Kirkhouse Road side a left turn only system will be in place so again please allow extra time for diversion routes.

Graham Road

Residents of Graham Road will be required to travel via Crosshead Road as no access will be available on to Main Street.

<u>Co-op</u>

Where possible access to the Co-op car park will be made available from the Balfron side only however, due to the legal closure in place it will be at the public's own discretion. We will, to the best of our ability, ensure that safe passage is available however, we will not be liable for any damage caused to any vehicles driving through the site. When the surface course is being laid access will be restricted to prevent damage to the material and ensure a safe working zone is maintained.

I apologies for any inconvenience caused during these works and for the late notification however, these works must be carried out to avoid any vehicle or pedestrian damage due to the continuing deterioration of the carriageway.

What precautions should be taken?

Hopefully we can keep any inconvenience caused by the operations to a minimum. However in order to minimise the inconvenience and for your own safety, we would be grateful if you can take the following precautions while work is ongoing in your area.

- 1. <u>Please do not park your car on any part of the road that will interfere with any works</u> <u>during working hours – this will allow the works to be carried out without delay.</u> If you need help getting in and out of your property, please ask the Roads Repair employees for assistance.
- 2. If you have no off road parking facilities and will be out when the work is due to be undertaken, we would be grateful is you would make alternative arrangements to move your vehicle.
- 3. It is a requirement under common law for all residents to protect their property. Please check in advance that there is no bitumen or tar on the shoes of any one getting into your car or entering your home. If there is any bitumen or tar on shoes, it may be necessary to remove them before entering the vehicle or property.
- 4. If, in spite of these precautions, you get bitumen or tar on your clothes or shoes, it can be removed with a proprietary cleaner.
- 5. In the case of business premises, we are obliged to maintain access, but as there are no practical ways in which we can cover the treated surfaces and cannot prevent people from walking over them, we suggest you place a temporary covering inside your premises.
- 6. In the case of business receiving deliveries if they cannot rearrange them, please coordinate with the Foreman on site who will assist as best he can.
