I can confirm that I am in agreement with the views of those present and feel that a multi-use path, incorporating the West Highland Way and then heading north across James Henderson's land, would be the safest and best model for families with buggies, bikes or wheel chairs, etc.

Having seen the preferred route of Stirling Council, my fears are that the pavement is (a) not wide enough for a family, and (b) would be dangerous for a pedestrians or children crossing the bridge on the B834 Station Road. As a local resident and business owner, I would be happier knowing that families could cycle or walk at a safe distance from traffic. I think it would be more beneficial to have a multi-use path connecting the village with the new development.
