

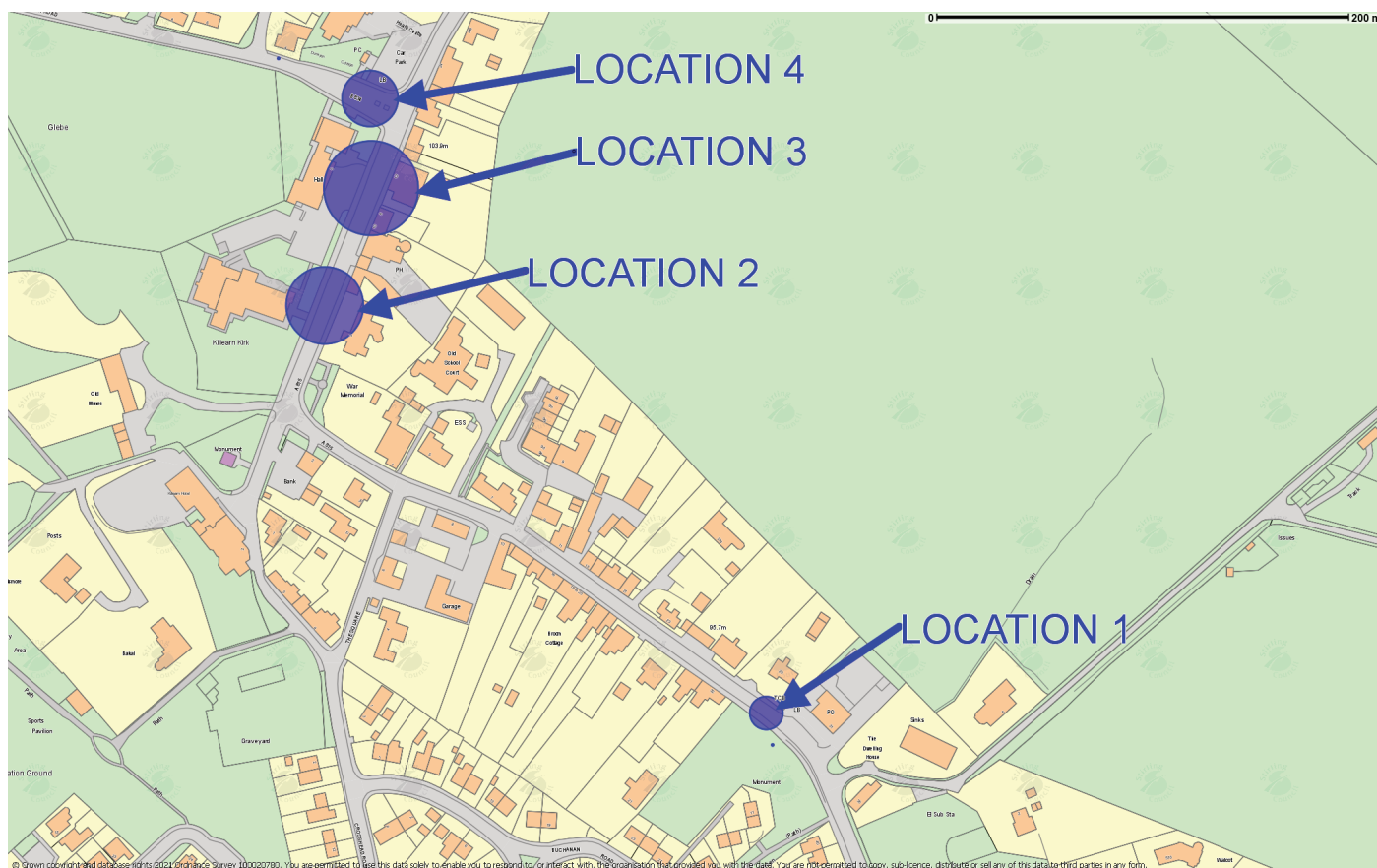


Stirling Council has advised that funding is available this financial year to implement a joint Road Safety/Safer Routes to Schools Project in Killearn. A zebra crossing is to be installed as part of this Project. The attached plan shows locations where crossings have been requested. Previous discussions had suggested a preferred location for a crossing on Main Street in the vicinity of the former Post Office building (Location 1 on the plan) and a number of requests have been received for a crossing to be installed at this location.

Additional funding has recently become available that will allow installation of a second zebra crossing. A number of requests have been received from members of the community in recent years requesting the installation of zebra crossings on Balfron Rd., between the junction of Station Road and the Church (Locations 2 and 3 on the plan) and at the top of Station Road (Location 4 on the plan). The installation of a zebra crossing at both Locations 1 and 2 would not result in the loss of parking as both of these sections of road are subject to double yellow lines. Parking would be lost if zebra crossings were installed at Locations 3 and 4.

The Council is undertaking feasibility studies for all four locations, but would welcome feedback from the Community in Killearn on the suggested locations and if possible to advise on preferred locations. Any funding for the crossings would need to be spent by end Mar. '22 – and an early response would be appreciated to allow design work to be undertaken as soon as possible.
