	<p>Incidents of Note</p> <p>The SSPCA along with assistance from Police Scotland executed a warrant on a property within the village due to concerns for the welfare of a number of dogs within the property. The animals were seized and treated. A report to the court will be submitted by the SSPCA.</p>

CROFTAMIE	<p>Crime</p> <p>A person was arrested and held as a custody for court the next day after police were called to a disturbance in the street. person then later breached their bail conditions set by the Court and was re-arrested.</p>

DRYMMEN	<p>Crime</p> <p>Road Traffic</p> <p>A driver failed to stop and exchange detail after their vehicle collided with another car, causing minor damage. Unfortunately, there are no further lines of enquiry.</p> <p>A driver was issued with a fixed penalty ticket for driving without due care and attention after overtaking another vehicle and colliding with another vehicle. Fortunately, the collision occurred at a slow speed, and no persons were injured.</p> <p>A driver has been reported to the Court for causing serious injury by dangerous driving after driving and colliding into an oncoming vehicle on the A988 towards Drymen which resulted in serious injury. Emergency services attended and treated the injured party.</p>

	<p>Drugs</p> <p>A person was stopped and searched by Police and was issued with a recorded Police warning after they found a small quantity of herbal cannabis.</p>

FINTRY	<p>Crime</p> <p>A quadbike and chainsaws were stolen from a barn at a property outside Fintry towards the end of December. Investigations are ongoing. Owners of quadbikes are reminded to be vigilant and ensure that their bikes are secure (physical locks such as chains, padlocks or handlebar locks and immobilisers, preferably locked within a secure shed and fitted with trackers etc.) to make them more difficult for thieves to target them.</p> <p>Incidents of note</p> <p>Diversions were put in place after a large tree came down across the road on the B818 from Fintry to the A875. Stirling Council Road Department explained that the tree was too large to be removed at the time which meant the diversion was in place overnight.</p>

The victim was given suitable safeguarding advice.</p> <p>A crime under the Sexual Offences (Scotland) Act has been recorded after an adult made contact via mobile phone with an older child and attempted to engage in a sexual conversation. Enquiries are ongoing to trace the suspect and the older child has been provided safeguarding advice.</p> <p>A crime under the communications act has been recorded after a resident received a threatening message. Enquiries are ongoing.</p> <p>A fraud is currently being investigated after a local business was made aware that a fraudulent website had been set up purporting to be their business. The business has received several queries asking where their orders are, there orders appear to have been made, along with payment to the fraudulent website.</p>

KIPPEN	Road Traffic <p>A collision occurred when a vehicle was driving along the A811 westbound towards Kippen and another vehicle pulled out from the Glynn's Road onto the A811. The driver was subject to a fixed penalty notice for causing the accident.</p>
