Police:

- Youths causing issues at the Primary School have been identified
- 'Pop up Policeman' to be used in local villages to slow traffic down
- Three persons fishing without a permit at loch on outskirts of Killearn have been charged
- Ongoing enquiries into theft by shoplifting from the Co-op
- Number of thefts from parked motor vehicles in the Mugdock Country Park area.





Planning:

- Former Killearn Hospital Site: SC has confirmed that CALA could look at an off-road 'link' path,
 possibly along part of the West Highland Way. Following comments from the floor on the pros and
 cons of such a route versus a path on A81 and up Station Road, it was agreed this be investigated
 further and consideration given to the costs involved
- Development of Former Killearn Hotel: Frustration was expressed by the developers at the slow progress with SC. They await Section 75 from SC before a demolition warrant can be applied for
- Rural Stirling Housing Association Lampson Road site: The SC Planning Panel which met on 8th December deferred their decision to allow for another application to be submitted.

Roads:

- Work has started within SC on a Gateway project for Killearn. It is hoped that this will encompass speed limiting measures and a pedestrian crossing on Main Street near 'The Outdoor Classroom'
- Work on improving the footpath at the lower end of Station Road has started, scope of works and expected timeline tbc.

Any other business:

- The 'Kitchen Window' café at Killearn Village Hall opened 23rd Dec.
- A mini lending library is to be housed within the Village Hall more details tbc.
- A few more interested parties are still needed for a potential wireless broadband service to Branziert Rd. and top of Drumbeg Loan to be viable, please contact Doug Ashworth through KCC (contactus@killearncc.org.uk) for further info
- The Balfron branch of the Bank of Scotland will close in March 2021 discussions are ongoing with regard to an alternative use for the building
- Congratulations to all involved in the Advent Window Scheme it has brightened windows, raised funds for Shelter Scotland and encouraged local residents to explore other parts of the village
