ARNPRIOR	Crime Extortion <p>A resident in the village has become a victim of extortion, after they engaged in a conversation with an anonymous account over social media. The conversation became sexualised with the suspect requesting naked images of the victim, who thereafter obliged. The suspect then threatened to share the images with friends and family if they did not send untraceable digital apple vouchers to them. After sending the apple vouchers, the suspect kept asking for more, realising this would not stop they contacted Police. Enquiries are ongoing.</p>

BALFRON	Crime Offensive weapon <p>A young person has been charged with carrying an offensive weapon to Balforn High school. A report has been submitted to the Procurator Fiscal.</p>

	<p>Vandalism</p> <p>The rear window of a parked car was smashed within the village and comments scratched into the bonnet. Unfortunately, there are no further lines of enquiry, and this remains undetected. Please continues to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activity.</p> <p>Enquiries are ongoing to trace a driver that filled their car up with fuel and thereafter fail to pay for said fuel.</p> <p>Road Safety</p> <p>A driver was arrested and charged for driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol. The driver was released on Police undertaking with the condition that they do not drive a motor vehicle. A report has been submitted to the procurator Fiscal for consideration.</p> <p>Another driver was arrested and charged for failing to provide a specimen of breath for a breath test. The driver was also charged with driving with no insurance, no MOT and carrying a knife. A report has been submitted to the procurator Fiscal.</p>

<p>BUCHLYVIE</p>	<p>Crime</p> <p>Theft</p> <p>A report was received in relation to a theft of scrap metal within the grounds of a property in the village. Unfortunately, there are no further lines of enquiry, and this remains undetected. Please continue to be vigilant and report any suspicious activity.</p> <p>Road Traffic</p> <p>The driver of a van has been reported to the Procurator Fiscal for exceeding the speed limit near to the Village.</p>

	<p>A lorry clipped the wingmirror of another passing vehicle and then failed to stop and exchange details with the driver. There are no further lines of enquiry, and this remains undetected.</p>

CROFTAMIE	<p>Crime</p> <p>A person was arrested and held as a custody after staff from a local B&B contacted Police reporting they were being drunk and abusive towards staff and other guests. The person was arrested for threatening behaviour and was also wanted on warrant.</p>

DRYMEN	<p>Crime</p> <p>Fraud / Theft</p> <p>Enquires are ongoing after a local business contracted accompany to install a ventilation system. The work had been completed and payment was made. The company thereafter went out of business, and it appears a subcontractor has removed the ventilation system due to not being paid. Enquires are ongoing.</p> <p>Theft of Motor vehicle</p> <p>A quad bike was taken from a local farm and left in a remote area (presumably to see if the Quad had a tracker) Fortunately, a dog walker discovered the quadbike and contacted Police arranged recovery.</p> <p>Road Safety</p> <p>A van collided with another vehicle, causing minor damage and failed to stop and exchange details. Unfortunately, there are no lines of enquiry.</p>

FINTRY	<p>Crime</p> <p>Theft and attempted thefts of motor vehicles (Quadbikes)</p> <p>Enquiries are ongoing into the theft of a quadbike and the attempted theft of another vehicle from a local Farm.</p> <p>Another crime of intended theft has been recorded after unknown persons entered the curtilage of another farm in the area.</p> <p>It appears these crimes along with theft of quadbikes are related and enquiries are ongoing to bring those responsible to justice.</p> <p>In the meantime, please continue to report any suspicious activity in the area. Fortunately, no one was seriously injured as a result.</p>

The offender was held in custody to appear at Court the next day.</p> <p>A crime under the computer misuse act has been recorded after a local resident replied to a spam email purporting to be from Outlook requesting the victim sends his email address and password, with they did. The suspect thereafter emailed all the victim's contacts asking them to send digital gift cards. Fortunately, no persons sent any money, and the victim has been provided with suitable security advice.</p>
