- Lampson Rd.

This Order will close Lampson Road from its junction with the B834 to its junction with Lampson Lane. This Order will also suspend the parking on Lampson Road on both sides of the road from its junction with the B834 in a south-easterly then north-easterly direction for a distance of 75 metres or thereby from **20-05-24 until 14-07-24 to facilitate public utility works.**
- A811, nr Balfron - Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Suspension of Parking)
This Order will close A811 From its junction with the C21 to its junction with the A81. This Order will also suspend the parking on: A811 From its junction with the C21 in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 300 metres or thereby from 0900 hours until 1800 hours from **10-6-24 until 17-6-24 to facilitate resurfacing works.**
